The Auburn 20-30 #19's 10th Annual Auburn Brewfest is coming up quickly! We would like to invite you to participate in this year's Brewfest on **June 9th 2018 from 4pm to 9pm** at the Gold Country Fairgrounds. We are expecting a large crowd again this year with 100% of the proceeds from our ticket sales going directly back to the Auburn community through our many projects benefiting the local youth. We are seeking donations and participation for our event; with your support we hope to raise the required funds needed for our many donation projects that include our Annual Christmas Shopping Spree and Community Easter Egg Hunt. We know there are many "brew fest" type events throughout year, and you receive many donation requests, but it is our hope you will join us and help us reach our goal of helping as many children in our community as possible.

This year we are excited to announce the formation of the Gold Country Children's Foundation (GCCF), a 501(c)(3) public charity. The GCCF gives us new opportunities and the ability to pass on the tax benefits of a charitable organization.

Our Brewfest is an open tasting event so we ask that you plan accordingly with the amount of product you intend to bring. Tasting may only be dispensed into the official Brewfest cups so no glass bottles, cans, or other containers shall be served to the attendees. All servers and volunteers handling alcoholic products must be over the age of 21, valid photo ID will be required. We will provide you with a 10' x 10' space, 6' table, ice, and required ABC licensing. Please make sure you or your distributor provides proper dispensing equipment if required. Should you need a larger space place contact us so we may make arrangements. Additional areas will be available for banners or signage in support of your brewery and product.

The grounds will open at 11am and all setup should be completed by 3:30pm, no vehicles will be allowed in the pavilion after 3:30pm. Please complete and return the attached registration form at your earliest convenience to guarantee your spot at our event. - If you need a copy of our liquor license we will gladly provide it to prevent any problems with pouring at our event.
- **ALL** servers and brewery staff **MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER OR THEY WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO THE EVENT.**
- You will have a 10' x 10' space. There will be a 6 foot folding table to use.
If you need more space, please let us know so we can prepare a larger space for you.
We will not be able to provide any dispensing equipment, if needed please bring the required equipment with your staff or have the needed equipment provided by your distributor.
A limited number of volunteers will be provided to assist if needed.
- The hours of the event are 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for beer tasting.
Gates will open at 4:00 p.m.
- Please have setup complete by 3:30 p.m.
- We will be giving out 4 vendor admission tickets per brewery.
Tickets can be picked up at "will call".

Thanks again and remember that this is a charitable event.
